**1. BACKGROUND:**

Throughout the world, R&D and business activities are becoming increasingly global and borderless, and the securing of Intellectual Property (IP) protection worldwide is becoming an extremely important issue. IP protection is a key factor in promoting foreign investment and technology transfer, as well as for boosting a nation's industrial development. It will also bring considerable economic benefits to Asian-Pacific nations. Therefore, the Japan Patent Office (JPO) has provided vigorous support for the education of human resources to reinforce the protection of intellectual property in developing countries.

This program, which has been organized every year since 1996, is funded by the JPO, and the operation of the program is entrusted to JIII and AOTS. It is intended mainly for persons working within the Intellectual Property Right (IPR) field in the private sector, such as enterprises, law firms, research institutes and educational organizations. There will be five different courses under the program, which participants will attend based upon their professions: Chinese IP practitioners, lawyers, IP practitioners, patent experts and IP trainers. The courses are designed to provide participants with a deeper understanding of IPR and the techniques required for smooth utilization of the IPR system.

### (2) Qualifications (for all candidates)

- 1) Candidates should be nominated by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce and Industry.
- 2) Candidates should be engaged in the field of IPR.
- 3) Candidates should be university graduates and/or have equivalent professional experience.
- 4) Candidates should be physically and mentally prepared to undergo an intensive training course.
- 5) Candidates should not be students or armed forces personnel.
- 6) Candidates should intend to continue in the same field after completing the training course.
- 7) AOTS ex-participants who have been awarded an AOTS Scholarship once within 1 year are not entitled to apply for this program.
- 8) Candidates should have adequate English language competence to attend lectures and discussions, as well as make reports. (Please refer to the Part 6 of the Application Form.).
- 9) Indian citizens working at Japanese enterprises in India are eligible for this program.
- 10) Candidates should **NOT** be governmental officials (Except Judges and Prosecutors wishing to participate in the “JPO/IPR Training Course for Lawyers.”)

### **3. PARTICIPATION FEE AND ALLOWANCES:**

Training expenses, including allowances to the participants, are financed by the JPO in accordance with the rules of JIII and AOTS.

The allowances will be provided to each participant as per Attachment (5).

### **4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:**

Participants will be requested to confirm their agreement with the “AOTS RULES RELATING TO TRAINEES OF THE JPO/IPR TRAINING PROGRAM,” which includes the following conditions:

- 1) Participants shall obtain a “Training Visa” by submitting the invitation documents supplied by AOTS to the Japanese Embassy or Consulate in India. Upon consultation with the JPO, AOTS may cancel the scholarship awarding of participants who enter Japan with the wrong kind of visa.
- 2) Tickets for air travel to and from Japan will be provided by AOTS. All participants are asked to ensure that they have made every necessary arrangement on their side before starting their journey to Japan. A participant who is unable to enter Japan before the beginning of the training course will lose his/her place. AOTS will arrange their flights for arrival in Japan the day before the

commencement of the training course and for departure the day after the end of the training course.  
No change in the route, class or flight date are allowed.

- 3) Participants shall not be accompanied by their family members to Japan during the training course.
- 4) Participants shall not request JIII or AOTS to arrange, nor arrange by themselves, any additional program during or after the training course.
- 5) Participants shall leave Japan and return home upon completion of the training course in Japan according to the original schedule offered by JIII and AOTS.

September 27 – October 15, 2010 (1-3 candidates)

[Application Deadline: August 2, 2010]

### 2. Objective:

To enhance knowledge required to disseminate intellectual property (e.g. legal systems, international treaties and methods of using patent information), and to deepen understanding of how to disseminate intellectual property (e.g. textbooks and implementation programs), as well as to learn about how to efficiently/effectively disseminate intellectual property through presentations and opinion exchanges with other trainees.

### 3. Target Participants (must meet all three requirements):

(1) Professional position (applicants must be one of the following):

- 1) Employees at universities or research institutions involved in education on the Intellectual Property system
- 2) Those engaged in the dissemination of the IPR in IP promotional organizations

(2) Target participants should have considerable knowledge of the IPR system as well as a desire to acquire knowledge about the dissemination of IPR.

(3) Target participants should be between 27 and 50 years of age, with more than three years of experience in work related to the education or dissemination of the IPR system in universities, research institutions or IP promotional organizations.
